Copy of the Special Election.

Notice is hereby given to the qualified Electors of the County of Iron that A Special Election will be held in said County and the same is hereby called for Monday July 31st 1893. For the Purpose of electing three County road Commissioners for said County one for the term of one year one for the term of two years and one for the term of three years whose term of office shall commence immediately upon filing the oath of office Required by law and shall continue for one two and three years respectively from May 1st 1894.

Notice is further given that the said election will be held on said 31st day of July 1893 in the School House on Section 27 in Township of Bates County of Iron the Poll of said Election will be opened at 7 o'clock in the forenoon or as soon thereafter as may be and will be continued open until 5 o'clock in the afternoon unless the Board shall in their direction adjourned the Polls at 12 o'clock noon for one hour Dated at Bates this 24th day of July A.D. 1893

A Special Election was held in the School house on section 27 School district no 1 in the Township of Bates on the 31st day of July A.D. 1893. As soon as the inspectors of Election were assembled they appointed Charles A. Olla as assistant Clerk and Olof H. Helgemo. Poll keeper of said Election after the above named members of the Board had taken the Constitutional oath of office prescribed by law the Poll was opened and was continued open until 5 o'clock in the

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Afternoon with the exception from 12. to one o'clock at which time the Board adjourned for one hour after having sealed the Ballot boxes as required by law after closing the Poll the votes was publicly counted by the Board of inspectors and the result was read by Israel Carlson Clerk of said election and drew up the following Statement A. Statement setting forth the whole numbers of votes cast at the said election for County Road Commissioners was Sixty nine 69 one fraudulent and destroyed ticket the whole numbers of votes for County Road Commissioner for three years David C. Lockwood Received (53) votes Hugh J. McLean Received (12) votes the whole number of votes cast for County Road Commissioner for two years Monville B. Waith Received (60) votes Mortimer M. Coffey Received (7) votes the whole number of votes cast for County Road Commissioner for one year Olof Helgrena Received (1) votes and Matthew E.
