Township of Bates

A meeting of the <sup>Board of the Township</sup> Township of Bates was held at the office of the Township Clerk in said Township of Bates on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1895 at 10 o'clock A.M.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman. The following members answered to their names as the roll was called,

Frank Erickson Supervisor

Adolf Forsberg Township Clerk

Ole Benson Justice of the Peace

August Krans Justice of the Peace

August Krans being a new member of the board in place of John E. Gronlund whose term of office expired on the fourth day of July last, it was moved by Adolf Forsberg supported by Ole Benson to admit the said August Krans a site in the board which motion was unanimously carried, the minutes of last meeting was read and on motion duly carried approved as read.

The following resolution was offered and a motion was made for its adoption by Adolf Forsberg supported by Ole Benson, Whereas it appears ~~to us the town board.~~ in the highway commissioner record that John Alt legally claimed and was awarded by the Commissioner of Highways the sum of \$50.<sup>00</sup> Fifty dollars for damages caused by running a highway through his land during the year of 1893. And Whereas it further appears that Frank Erickson also claimed and was awarded by the said Commissioner the sum of \$35.<sup>00</sup> Thirty five dollars for damages caused by running a highway through his land at the time aforesaid, and Whereas it further appears that that Charley Noren legally claimed and was awarded by the said Commissioner of Highways the sum of \$100.<sup>00</sup> one hundred dollars

for damages caused by running a highway through his land at the time aforesaid, and that a sum of Fifty dollars still remain unpaid, and Whereas a demand have been made for the payment of the said claims by the persons intitled thereto be it therefore hereby Resolved that an order be drawn upon the highway fund in favor of the said John Alt for the amount of \$50<sup>00</sup> and also an order upon the said fund be drawn in favor of the said Frank Erickson for the amount of \$35<sup>00</sup> and also an order upon the same fund be drawn in favor of the said Charley Noren for the amount of \$50<sup>00</sup> for the payment of the said damages claims, and that the amount of said orders be levied and collected on the taxroll in the same manner as other taxes are levied and collected, which motion prevailed by all the members of the said board, board then went into Committee of the whole for the purpose of examining and allowing the following bills presented to the board for consideration, It was moved by Ole Benson supported by Adolf Forsberg that the board allow the following bills and the Chairman and Clerk was instructed to draw orders for the same upon such funds upon the township upon which the same are allowed.
