 on motion duly carried approved as read,  
 It was moved by Adolf Forsberg supported  
 by August Krans that the bill of Doctor  
 Darling for \$60.<sup>00</sup> for professional  
 service rendered to Edward Sjogvist  
 be allowed at \$40.<sup>00</sup> which motion  
 was duly carried by all the members  
 of the board, it was further moved  
 by Adolf Forsberg supported by August  
 Krans that the bill of J. C. Wilkinson  
 for \$22.<sup>85</sup> for medicine furnished to  
 poor be allowed at \$21.<sup>00</sup> which motion  
 prevailed by all the members present,  
 it was further moved by Adolf Forsberg  
 supported by Ole Benson to lay the  
 bill of Victor Demango on the table  
 until the Highway Commissioner have  
 inspected the work for which the said  
 bill was presented to the Board  
 which motion was also duly carried,  
 it was moved by August Krans supported  
 by Ole Benson to instruct the Clerk  
 to notify the Highway Commissioner  
 to not construct or repair any roads
