

## Proceedings of Township Board.

Township of Boler Sep 14<sup>th</sup> 1900.

Pursuant to call by Charley Olson Supervisor  
A Meeting of the Township Board of the Township  
of Boler was held at the office of the Township  
Clerk on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Sep. A.D. 1900.

Meeting called to order by the Chairman  
Clerk. called the roll and the following members  
was present. Charley Olson. Supervisor  
Israel Carlson. Clerk. Edward Sjogrist. and  
Victor Benson. Justice of the Peace.

Moved by Carlson. Supported by Sjogrist that  
Victor Benson be allowed a seat at this board  
in place of John Soderqvist. whose term of office  
was expired on the last 4<sup>th</sup> day of July 1900.  
which said motion was unanimously carried.

Minutes of last meeting was read and approved  
as read. The following Resolution was offered  
by Charley Olson. and its adoption was moved  
by Benson. Supported by Sjogrist.

Whereas the M.L.I. Co. had refused to pay of the taxes  
assessed on the lands against the company in this  
Township for the year 1898. on the ground that there  
had been some Homesteaders settled on said lands.

And whereas said company had made an offer  
to this board that they are willing to pay up  
the full amount taxes assessed on said lands  
against the company and due this Township of Boler.  
Provided that the Township board are willing to  
allow a rebate to the company for half the interest  
and fees due this Township for the taxes so assessed  
against the company. Therefore be it Resolved  
by the Township board of this Township of  
Boler now assembled in regular session on  
the 14<sup>th</sup> day of Sep. 1900. That this board allow  
a Rebate to said company for half the interest and  
collection fees on said taxes assessed on the lands  
belonging to said company.

Provided the said company pay in full the amount due this Township and the other half interest and collection fees now remain unpaid on said lands the roll was called on the above resolution Olson yes. Carlson yes. Sjogrist yes Benson yes. The vote being for the adoption of the resolution Moved by Benson. Seconded by Sjogrist.

that the Library Money that may be apportioned to this Township by the County Treasurer for the current year be used for General School purposes in place of establishment and maintenance of a Township Library which motion prevailed by all the members of the board. The following Resolution was offered by Olson and its adoption was moved by Carlson supported by Benson. Whereas Mr. Peter S. Johnson of this Township has been partially supported by the Supervisor. and. Whereas said Peter S. Johnson in the opinion of this board are able to do work and support himself and. Whereas he also is a hard drinker. and. Whereas the family of said. Peter S. Johnson had left him and now reside in Iron River Township and support themselves. Therefor be it resolved that the supervisor be instructed not to issue any more Poor. orders to said Peter S. = Johnson. The above resolution was duly adopted by an unanimous vote of all the members of the board.

Moved by Sjogrist Supported by Benson. That the board allow \$3<sup>50</sup>. for house rent to Nels Kyallstrom for Mrs Nyset. Motion carried by an unanimous vote of all the members; board went into committee of the whole for the purpose of auditing and allowing the following bills brought before the board for consideration. moved by Benson. Supported by Sjogrist that the following bills be allowed and the Chairman and Clerk be instructed to issue orders for the same upon the proper funds of this Township. and the Chairman and Clerk than proceeded to draw orders as follows
