

Township of Bates, July 21st 1902.

A Meeting of the Township board of the Township of Bates, was held at the office of the Township Clerk, on the 21st day of July A. D. 1902.

Meeting called to order by the chairman
Clerk called the roll and the following
members was present

Charley Olson Supervisor.

Israel Carlson Clerk.

Victor Forsberg, Justice of the Peace
Moved by Forsberg, seconded by Carlson,
that this board allow Olof W. Fryborn,
a seat at this board, in place of Victor
Benson, whose term of office as Justice of
Peace was expired on the last fourth day
of July A. D. 1902. Motion carried
Minutes of Last meeting was read and
Approved as read.

The following resolution was offered by
Forsberg and its adoption was moved by
Fryborn and supported by Carlson, whereas
the School house and lot, at Dist No 2,
of this Township of Bates, was sold and
Bid in by the Supervisor of this Township
for the sum of \$ 110⁰⁰ one hundred and
Ten Dollars, and whereas the Township board
of this Township of Bates, assembled in regular
session on the 21st day of July A. D. 1902,
therefore be it resolved by us that the
Township of Bates take possession of said
property and to pay to the board of Education
the said sum of \$ 110⁰⁰ when said board
of Education Deliver to the Township
board a clear Deed on said property,
and be it further resolved that the
Supervisor and Clerk be and is hereby
Authorized and instructed to draw and

Order on contingent fund to pay for said property when clear deed are received. roll called on the adoption of said resolution, and resulted as follows. Olson yes. Carlson, yes Forsberg, yes. Trybom, yes. Motion Unanimously Adopted and carried. Moved by Forsberg, and seconded by Trybom that Board allow Ole Benson, \$11⁷⁵ ^{rebate} as interest on Taxes for year 1894-96-97. and that Chairman and Clerk be instructed to divide said amount and draw orders for the same as follows. \$5⁸⁹ out of contingent fund and \$5⁸⁹ from highway fund. Roll called and resulted as follows. Olson yes. Carlson yes Forsber yes Trybom yes. Motion duly adopted and carried.

Board then went into committee of the whole for the purpose of auditing and allowing the following bills presented to the board for consideration. Moved by Carlson, seconded by Forsberg, that the following bills be allowed and the Chairman and Clerk, be instructed to draw orders for the same, and Chairman and Clerk, then proceeded to draw orders as follows.
