

Bater Township Feb 4<sup>th</sup> 1907

The following are the minutes of a meeting held by the Township Board of Bater Township at the clerk's office on the 4<sup>th</sup> Day of Feb. A.D. 1907 meeting called to order by Charley Olson Clerk called the roll and the following members were present Charley Olson Supervisor Victor Benson Clerk Gotthard Nordin Justice of the Peace August Johnson Absent. Minutes of last meeting were read and approved or read. A question was brought up by the Commissioner of Highways as to the necessity of having one additional Road Grader. Said Commissioner claiming that the situation is such that our Road Grader is insufficient and not enough for the amount of Roads to be kept in repair and in a possible condition. Therefor it was moved and reported that the clerk be instructed to correspond with some Road Machine Company and to secure Prier and Callaghan in order to obtain a good substantial Grader for the Township Roads of Bater motion carried it was moved by Nordin seconded by Olson that the Contingent Highway & Poor Bills be allowed with the exception of Morrettor Mercantile Company for Provisions for John Dobson be sent back ~~early~~ <sup>at once</sup> of the Hill officer motion carried

A question was brought up by the Highway Commissioner of Highways as to the necessity of having one additional Road Grader said Commissioner claiming that that the situation is such that our Road Grader is insufficient and not enough for for the amount of Roads to be kept in repair and in a possible condition therefor it was moved and reported that that the clerk be instructed to correspond with some Road Machine Company and to secure Callaghan and Prier. motion carried

it was moved by Nordin supported by Olson that all the Contingent & Highway Bills be allowed, and the Poor Bill of Morrison Mercantile Company be returned for correction as to be itemized and verified by the health Officer motion carried.

it was moved and supported that the Bill of Mercy Hospital for Peter J. Johnson be disallowed.
