Township of Sales March 24<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1908

A meeting of the Twp. Board for the Township of Sales was held in the Town Hall on the above date. The meeting was called to order by the chairman. Adolf Forsberg Clerk being absent it was moved by Nordin and seconded by Lingquist.

The office of Deputy Clerk having become vacant by Forsberg being quarantined it was moved by Nordin and seconded by Lingquist that we appoint Charley Olson Deputy Clerk for the unexpired term. Roll called on above motion. Victor Benson Supervisor yes Nordin yes Lingquist yes Motion carried.

A motion was duly made and seconded that the bill of Erick Berg for a ditch cut through his Land and for Sunset Lake Road be paid for one half \$25<sup>00</sup> at this meeting and the other half \$25<sup>00</sup> in February 1909. All the members voting yeas for the above motion. Chairman declared motion carried.

A motion was made by Lingquist seconded by Nordin. The two election tickets named Tax Peoples Ticket and Tax-payers Tickets be excepted and to instruct the Clerk to cause said Tickets to be printed. The above motion prevailed by all members voting yeas.

A motion was made by Nordin seconded by Lingquist that we fix the Bonds for the Twp. Clerk at \$1000<sup>00</sup> and the Bonds for Twp. Treasurer at \$8000. for the ensuing year all the members voting yeas motion carried.

Township of Bates April 10<sup>th</sup> 1908

A meeting of the town board of Bates Township was held at the town hall in said township on Friday the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1908.

The meeting was called to order by Victor Benson Chairman. The clerk called the roll and the following members was present Victor Benson Supervisor, Adolf Forsberg Township clerk Gothard Nordin and Aldo Lindquist Justices of the Peace.

Adolf Forsberg being duly Elected Township Clerk at the annual town ship meeting (Election) presented his official bond which was duly approved and accepted. Edward Sjogrist Commissioner of Highways then presented his official bond which said bond was also duly approved and accepted. The board then proceeded to appoint a health officer for the ensuing year.

August Krans and Frank Erikson being applicants for said office the board proceeded to ballot with the result that 3 ballots were cast in favor of August Krans and one ballot was cast in favor of Frank Erikson. August Krans being declared duly appointed. The following resolution was then offered by Adolf Forsberg who moved its adoption.
