

Bates Township March 31st 1913.

A meeting of the Township Board of the township of Bates was held in the town Hall on the 31st day of March A. D. 1913 at nine o'clock in the forenoon the meeting was called to order by Charley Olson Chairman and the members of the Board answered to their names as follows Olson Present Benson Present. Gordon Present Kraus Present. The minutes of the previous meeting was read by the Clerk to the Board and upon a motion being duly made & supported was ordered to stand as read. The Board then proceeded to settle with the Township treasurer and it was found that the Books of the treasurer was corresponding with the books Records & accounts of the Township clerk and the following resolution was offered by Olof Benson, who moved its adoption where on we the township Board of the township of Bates find the accounts of the treasurer Charley Olson with the statement of receipt and disbursements during the year and with the Clerks accounts there fore be it resolved that we the Township Board accept said statement in full settlement with said township treasurer Charley Olson. This resolution was supported by Gerhard Gordon. Roll called. Olson yes Benson yes. Gordon yes. Kraus yes motion duly carried. The board then took up the question of fixing the township treasurer's Bond and the following resolution was offered by Gordon. Be it resolved that we the Township Board of the Township of Bates do hereby fix the Bond of the Township treasurer at ten thousand dollars \$10,000.00 for the next year. Roll called Olson yes Gordon yes Benson yes Kraus yes. Motion duly carried. The Board then took up the question of fixing the township Clerks Bond and a motion was made by Olof Benson and supported by Gordon to fix the township Clerks

Bond at One thousand dollars \$1000.00 for the next year Roll called. Olson yes. Benson yes. Warden yes. Kraus yes. motion duly carried. The Proceedings of the two Primary Elections were examined by the Board and it was moved by Alf Benson & supported by Warden that the Clerk be instructed to make an original copy of the two tickets and to have two hundred of said ticket printed. motion duly carried. by Board. the Clerk then read the Bills to the Board and upon motion being made by Benson & supported by Warden to allow call Bills as read. Roll called. Olson yes. Benson yes. Warden yes. Kraus yes. motion duly carried. The following Orders were then issued on the different funds and countersigned by the Clerk and Chairman.
