The following are the minutes of the proceedings of the annual township meting of the docunshifo of Bates held on Monday, apr. 1,1918 at the down Stale in said township.

Meeting called to order at 7;00 o' clock a N\%. The election board was then duly organized as follows:Chairman - August Krano, Clerks - Victor benson, Conrad Rosendale, Inspectors-Mike Le Clair, Emil Ihunander, Gatikeper - Gd vyborg. The constitutional oatho of office were then administered to the inspectors, clerks and gatekeeper: which oaths were then placed in the poll books provided for the day and filed in the clerk's office.

The ballot bor was then examined by the board of election and the contents removed therefrom; where upon the ballot bop was locked and the keys delivered to mire Le Clair, one of the unspectoro designated by a motion of the board of inspectoro.
The chairman then announced the pollo opened or the election of offricis as provided by the otaterte for this day, which was proclaimed by the gatikejer.
The ballots were opened and prepared for balloting and voting commenced at 7:15- 'lock and. continued till 12:00 d'cloch a.m; whereupon g, ties. polls were closed hi u. for dinner. at 1:00. Clocker. it: was proclaimed by the gatekeeper that the business to be transacted by viva voce vote would be commenced. Adolf gorsberg, sufecrisor of said township called the meeting to order and acted. as moderator of the meeting. Galmer Gohneono, clerk of said township acted as clerk of the meeting. There were 52 qualified votio present. I he financial statimento which had been printed in booklet form were then discussed. The matter of raising money in the various

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funds was then brought up.
Moved by Charley Olson that ${ }^{8} 100$ be raised for the contingent fund. No one supporting the motion, the moderator declared said motion not carried.

Moved by August Trans and seconded by Frank Erickson that $\%, 000$ be raised for the contingent fund. Moderator stated vote stood as follows:- Aijes - 50, Nays 2. Motion carrical. moved by avigust gohnson and supported by Leonard Lind that $\$$, ,oo be raised for the road repair find. Moderator declared vote stood as fallows. Ayes-45, nays \%. Motion carried.

Moved by Frank Eivikeon, seconded by Charles Langendorf that 6,000 be raised for the highway improvement fund. Moderator declared vote stood as follows: ayes -48, nag. 4.
Matesin carried
Moved by August Trans, supported by Andrew Erickson that 500 be raised for the purpose of improving the cemetery. Moderator declared said motion carried, all voters voting for it, none against it.

No further bisixies coming before the voter the motion was made and dilly supported that vive adjourn. Motion carried.

The polls were then declared opened for further balloting for officers, by the gate heifer. at H:00 'clock the gatekeeper proclaimed that in 1 hi the polls would close; at 4:30 o'cloch, he poovliained the polls would close in 30 minutes; at 4:4.50'elock, he proclairied, the polls, would close in 15 minutes; at 5:00. o' dock, ho prochairned the polls would thin close; whirurpon the chairman stated. that the poll were closed.
