

Minutes of the Annual Meeting held in the Bates township hall on Monday April 3rd 1923.

It was moved by Andrew J. Waite that (\$2000.00) two thousand dollars be raised by taxation upon the taxable property of said township to defray Contingent expenses for the ensuing year, such fund to be known as the Contingent Fund. This motion was seconded by Emil Soderquist. Upon vote being taken, 16 votes were given in favor of said motion and 14 votes were given against said motion. Motion Carried.

It was moved by August Hanson and seconded by Wilbur Winton Sr. that (\$500.00) be raised by taxation upon the taxable property of said township of Bates for care and maintenance of the Bates Cemetery, such tax to be known as the Cemetery fund. Upon vote being taken, 27 votes were given in favor of said motion and no votes against said motion. Motion Carried.

It was moved by Frank Erickson and seconded by Wilbur Winton Sr. that (\$1000.00) be raised by taxation upon the taxable property of said Bates township for improvements and repair on Bates township hall, such tax to be known as the Town hall fund. Upon vote being taken 22 votes were given in favor of said motion and no votes against said motion. Motion Carried.

It was moved by Frank Erickson seconded by Emil Thumander that \$15,000.00 be raised by taxation upon the taxable property of said Bates township for the Highway improvement fund. Upon vote being taken 27 were given in favor of said motion and no votes against said motion. Motion Carried.

It was moved by Frank Erickson and seconded by Guy Winton that (\$20,000.00) twenty thousand dollars be raised by taxation upon the taxable property of said Bates township for the Road Repair fund. Upon vote being taken it was found that 31 votes were given in favor of said motion and 6 votes against said motion. Motion Carried.

Moved by Johnson and seconded by Waite that the bills for the following be allowed as read and the Clerk and Chairman be ordered to draw orders for the same.
