whereas a condition exists with to said funds which makes it imperative and necessary that the said twp borrow money for said funds in anticipation of the collection of taxes for the current year in order that the work of said twp. in Road Repair and Highway Imp Funds may be carried.

Therefore be it resolved that the Twp of Bates will borrow sums of money for said two funds up to the maximum amount allowed by law at a lawful rate of interest.

Be it further resolved that the supervisor and Clerk of said twp be and they are hereby appointed a committee to negotiate and complete said loans consistent with the terms of hereof.

Be it further resolved that the said Supervisor and Clerk be and they are hereby appointed and empowered by this Board for and in behalf of said township to make execute and deliver to the person or persons firm or firms corporation or corporations banking or otherwise the necessary and proper ~~ex~~ evidences of debt covering said loans.
