Township of Bates, July 5th 1907.

A meeting of the building committee was held on the fifth 5th day of July C. D. 1907 at 8 o'clock A. M. The committee met at the Forks of the County road going to Crystall Falls and Amasa, for the purpose of selecting a site for the Town hall, and it was decided to secure a site, to wit;— A parcel of land East of the Langerdorf Road and 100 feet North then East to the Olson's road about on $\frac{1}{4}$ of an acre and it was agreed between Oels Hanson and the above named committee that we pay the said Oels Hanson the sum of Twenty five Dollars for said parcel of land, and it was moved and supported that Victor Benson be appointed to secure a Deed for said parcel of land and it was also decided that the size of the Town Hall be 30 x 64 feet with 10 foot studding. Nothing more was before the committee we then on motion adjourned.
